

Dear Parents and Carers,

To ensure that you stay on top of your school accounts in ParentPay, we do have a strict policy on payments. We expect parents to pay for the use of the breakfast and teatime club a **month in advance**. This not only ensures that your child's place has been secured, but also supports you with upkeep of payments. Once you have fallen into twenty or more pounds arrears, unfortunately, you will no longer be able to use this facility until the debt has been cleared. As soon as the account has been topped up, we are happy for you to continue to use the teatime and breakfast clubs.

Similarly, we expect school meals to be paid for a **month in advance**. When you fall into a negative balance, the school will send you a text message to remind you to top up the next month's payment. Once you fall below £10 into credit, we will call you to remind you to top up your account and that there is a £20 cap on school dinner debt. Failing to top up your account may result in your child not being able to have a hot dinner. Once £20 debt has been incurred, your child will no longer be able to have school dinners. Parents will need to provide a packed lunch until the debt has been cleared and the account has been topped up with the next months' payment.
