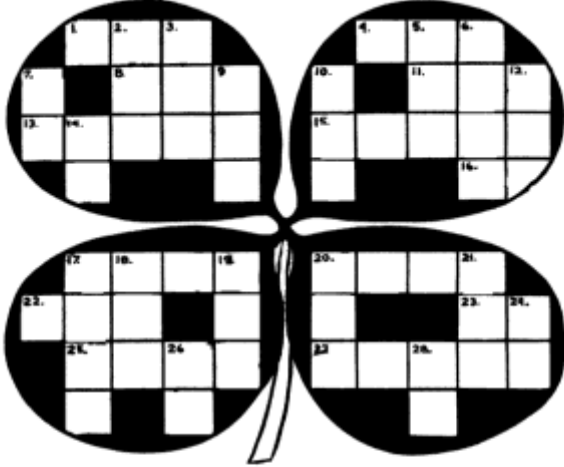
IMPORTANT REMINDERS
