

Dear Parent/Carer,

Nationally, there have been concerns around physical inactivity and childhood obesity. Across the UK, around 35% of pupils in their final year of Primary are categorised as overweight or obese.

Experts have described this as an epidemic and a crisis that must be tackled before it is too late. The World Health Organisation regards childhood obesity as one of the most serious global public health challenges for the 21st Century.

To tackle this, Davies Lane will be taking on the 'The Daily Mile', an initiative aimed to tackle lack of fitness and combat inactivity and obesity. The Daily Mile is very simple. Without wasting time to change into kit, every child in school goes out in the fresh air to run, jog or walk for 15 minutes. It is not competitive: most children will average a mile in that time, with some doing more and some doing less. It is not PE, sport or cross-country but a physical activity which is aimed at improving the children's physical, social, emotional and mental health wellbeing. It can help children to focus and concentrate in the classroom and raise their attainment.
