

Dear Parents and Carers,  
I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents and children about the importance of wearing the correct school uniform each day. Our uniform consists of a white collared shirt with grey trousers, a grey pinafore (R-Y2) or a grey skirt (Y3-Y6). Socks should be grey with trousers or white with skirts. Head scarves and tights should be grey. All pupils need to have a red Davies Lane jumper or cardigan with the school logo. We also have red fleeces with the school logo, which may be worn in the colder weather that we are now experiencing. School shoes must be worn, trainers are not acceptable, neither are boots. Due to health and safety requirements, larger hoop earrings are not permitted. Children who have pierced ears may only wear small hoops or stud earrings to school. Nail polish is not permitted to be worn in school. We are very proud of who we are as a school and like to present ourselves as a proud and smart community. Thank you for supporting us in ensuring our pupils look smart and fly the Davies Lane flag high!
