Term: Autumn 1
Topic: Myself and My Family
Hand in date: 29.09.16

What I need to do:

You will need to paint or draw a picture of yourself and your family. Then create a photo frame for your picture using sticks, buttons, leaves, flowers.



Week 1: Draw a picture of yourself and your family using paints or pencils.

Week 2: Collect some materials that you would like to use in creating your photo frame e.g. flowers, leaves, lolly sticks, twigs or buttons.

Week 3: Assemble your photo frame.

Questions to think about:

- Who are the people in your family?
- What family members live in a different house?
- What does your mum and dad look like?
- What materials would you like to use to make your frame?

How an adult can help me:

- Share pictures of me and our family so that I can draw a picture of them.
- Help me to find different materials in the house and garden for my photo frame.
- Support me to cut and stick my materials carefully when creating my photo frame.

Skills I will use:

- Showing an understanding of who is in my family.
- Constructing with a purpose in mind; using a variety of resources.
- Selecting appropriate tools and techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials.

Context: This half term we will be learning about ourselves and our families. We will be looking at our faces and the different features we have and how they make us unique. We will also be learning about different cultures, occupations and ways of life.

Literacy and Numeracy Activities:

Week 1:

Literacy: Can you name the different family members you live with?

Ext: Can you make a list of the family members you do not live with?

Numeracy: Can you count how many family members live with you?

EXT: Can you write numbers 0-5?

Week 2: Literacy: Can you describe what your mum/dad looks like? E.g. My mum has brown eyes.

Ext: Can you write 'm' for mum?

Numeracy: Can you make a face using 2d shapes?

Ext: Can you name some of the shapes you have used?



Week 3: Literacy: Can you find some objects in your house starting with 't' for tap?

Ext: Can you draw some of the objects you have found?

Numeracy: Can you count how many different materials you have collected for your photo frame?

Ext: Can you sort your materials in different ways (e.g. by colour, by size, by shape)?

Resources I will need:

- Paper, straws, pencils, paint, scissors, glue, sticks, buttons, leaves .
- Pictures of myself and my family.
- A mirror.
