Topic: Myself, my family and seasons

What I need to do:

As part of your homework you will need to - draw members of your family and create a 3D model of your home.

Week 1: Can you draw a self portrait small enough to fit in your house?

Week 2: Can you draw and cut out members of your family?

Week 3: Can you collage a house?

Questions to think about:

How many eyes do you have? What colour is your face? What shape is your nose? What colour are your eyes? What colour is your hair? What does your house look like? How many members are in your family?

How an adult can help me: Read my favourite story. Say words clearly so I can hear the first sounds. Help me hold my pencil and support me when I need it. An adult can support me in using scissors.

Resources I will need: Art supplies; junk boxes, glue, scissors, scrap materials /tissue paper to collage, colouring pencils and paper.

Literacy and Numeracy Activities:


Week 1:

Literacy: Can you say and write the first sound for some animals from the story 'On my way home'?



EXT: Can you sound out and write the names of animals? E.g. d o g, c a t.

Numeracy: Can you label your fingers 1 - 10?



Ext: Can you label your fingers and toes from 1 - 20?

Week 2:

Literacy: Can you share an experience of when you visited the doctors? Why did you go? What did you see? How did you feel?

Ext: Can you draw and label the doctor surgery?

Numeracy: Can you compare these amounts saying which is more and less?

6 and 10 7 and 9

12 and 3 13 and 8

Ext: How many more or less do you need to make the two amounts the same?

Week 3:

Literacy: Can you discuss the role of a fire-fighter?

Ext: Can you describe the fire-fighters using adjectives?

E.g. The firemen is strong. He is brave.

Numeracy: Can you order three items by length?

Ext: Can you label the items using key vocabulary? E.g. short, shorter, shortest.

Skills I will use:

Holding a pencil and using it correctly to form sounds and numbers.

Handling scissors correctly to cut.

Hearing the first sounds in spoken words and attempting to link the sounds to letters.

Learning my numbers and knowing the value of it.

Extension:

If you have finished your homework and wish to continue now try: Can you count how many red cars you pass on your way to school?
