Numeracy:

Number recognition, number formation

Place value - Ordering numbers to 100, recognising number sequences (counting in 1s, 2s and 5s).

Addition and subtraction - counting on/taking away using objects, adding and subtracting using a numberline.

Time - Ordering months of the year, days of the week and times of the day.

Length - using non-standard units of measurement to measure objects and distances.

Shape and Space - Learning and recognising the features of 2D shapes, reading co-ordinates and using directional language.

Word problems - Solving money problems in real life contexts.

Creative Curriculum:

Science: Exploring the features of common plants and trees. Conducting experiments to investigate how plants grow and making observations of seasonal changes and their impacts on the environment.

History: We are going to be comparing old and new homes and homes from around the world.

Geography: We will use atlases, maps and globes to identify countries in the UK and their key features.

RE: Our focus is Christianity- we will be looking at the significance of Baptism and the birth of Jesus.

PSHE: We will look at the importance of being healthy: healthy diet, exercise, being happy and confident.

Computing: We will be creating simple codes and familiarising ourselves with word document. We will promote E-safety on the internet.

Art/DT: We will be learning to use different materials for effect to create different models and pieces of art, including flags of the British Isles, national dishes and hats based of national flowers. In DT we will be designing and creating a dish using vegetables from the U.K. We will also be making different building structures (houses) using junk modelling.

Music: We will be learning to sing in time and unison; identifying the beat and rhythm.

PE: We will be exploring different apparatus, copying, repeating and creating simple dance and gymnastic routines.
