Topic: Coast to coast

Context: This term we will be learning about the United Kingdom and Ireland. We will start the term by looking at our community and branch out to the wider parts of the British Isles. Areas we will cover are: the national foods, flags, flowers as well as the human and natural geography.

What I need to do:

Week 1: Think about your family and the people you know where you live.

Week 2: Think about the places you visit where you live.

*What is your favourite place?

Week 3: Think about your hobbies and any clubs you go to.

*What do you like to do at the weekend?

Week 4: Can you choose how to record your information?

Eg. Drawings/photographs scrapbook/Diary/Factfile.

Literacy and Numeracy Activities:

Week 1: Literacy: Can you write a list of bossy verbs (mix, go, sit)?

Extension: Can you put some of your ideas into a sentence?

Numeracy: Can you instruct a member of your family from one place to another using positional language?

Week 2 Literacy: Can you write a set of instructions about how you make your breakfast? Ext: Can you underline the describing words?

Numeracy: Can you partition these numbers: 13, 17, 22, 38, 125?

Extension: Can you think of your own numbers to partition?

Week 3 Literacy: Make a plan of a fairy tale of your own choice?

Ext: Can you add some describing words?

Numeracy: Write the numbers 1 to 10 in words. EXT: Can you make it to 20? E.g. 1 one, 2 two.

Week 4 Literacy: Can you use your plan to write the beginning of your story? Ext: Circle your capital letters and full stops.

Numeracy: Can you write a list of numbers that have 3 Tens? Ext: Now write some with 3 units.

Skills I will use:

I will be observing, sketching, labelling, reading, researching, note taking, collecting, describing and creating.

Questions to think about:

What places do you like in your local area?

What people do you know and visit in your local area?

How are you going to display the things you find?

How an adult can help me: Help me think of a way to display the information. Take me for a walk around my local area. Help me find information safely on the internet.
