What I need to do:

Create your fact file showing everything you have learnt about games.

How an adult can help me:

Resources I will need:

Questions to think about:

What games do your family enjoy playing?

How can someone win a game?

Context: This term our topic will be Toy Story. We will be learning about toys from the past and the present and how they work. Children will have the opportunity to design and make their own toys. We will be visited by The Little Angel Puppet Theatre where the children will be given the chance to utilise their puppet making skills.

Literacy and Numeracy Activities:

Week 1:

Literacy: Can you use adjectives in sentences to describe your favourite toy? E.g. My favourite toy has a pair of fluffy ears, a button nose and dark eyes.


Ext: Can you use similes to describe your favourite toy?

Phonics: 'sh' - Can you think of words using this sound?

Eg. Shop. Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly?

Numeracy: Can you read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words? Eg. 13 - thirteen

EXT: What other ways can you show these numbers

Week 2

Literacy: Ask your parent or carer about their favourite childhood toy? Compare it to your favourite toy- what is the same? What is different? E.g. My Mum used to play with a china doll that was delicate, fragile and beautiful. But, my doll is plastic, colourful and charming.

Phonics: 'th' - Can you think of words using this sound?

Eg. Thank you. Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly?

Numeracy: Can you pick two coins and show the biggest amount first. Eg. 10p 2p. Try to add them together eg. 10p + 2p =12p

Ext: How many ways can you make 10p using 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p?

Week 3

Literacy: Can you write instructions for playing a game? E.g. First, pick a colour. Next, place your counter on the board. Ext: Can you circle your capital letters and full stops?

Phonics: 'ch' - Can you think of words using this sound? Eg. Chase. Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly?

Numeracy: Can you count in steps of 2? How could you visually show this in different ways? (cherries, socks, gloves, eyes) Ext: Can you repeat this activity for counting in steps of 5 and 10?

Handwriting: Practice writing these words joined up.
