Literacy and Numeracy Activities:

Week 1:

Literacy: Can you use similes to describe the character from the book you are reading? **Ext:** Can you circle the capital letters and full stops?

Phonics: 'igh' - Can you think of words using this sound? Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly?

Numeracy: Can you find pairs of numbers that total 20?

Ext: Can you use 3 numbers to make twenty? How many different ways can you find?

Week 2

Literacy: Can you create a poster to advertise your game?

Ext: Can you think of persuasive language to sell your game?

Phonics: 'ee' - Can you think of words using this sound? Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly

Numeracy: Can you add a one digit number to a teen number? (Using numbers 1-4 for units and 11-15 for teen numbers)

Ext: Can you try bridging 10? Eg: 7+18=

Week 3

Literacy: Can you create a name and a slogan for your game? **Ext:** Can you use alliteration in your game name? E.g. Slithering Slimy Snakes.

Phonics: 'ea' - Can you think of words using this sound? Can you put them into sentences? Can you form the letters correctly? **Numeracy:** Can you get 20 objects i.e. dried pasta and take away different amounts to find a total? **Ext:** Record this as a number sentence.

Skills I will use:

I will be researching, collecting, playing, cutting, sticking, designing, drawing, writing and evaluating.

How an adult can help me: Help me collect materials I will need. Help me build my game. Play my game and review it with me.
