What I need to do:

As part of your homework you will need to research a toy of your choice from around the world.

Week 1: Research toys from around the world using books or the Internet and pick your favourite.

*Why have you chosen this toy?

Week 2: Find exciting facts from your research to include in your final piece.

* How is your toy different to toys from the UK?

Week 3: Present your fantastic facts in an eye-catching way of your choice, (poster, fact-file, model, written piece).

* How will you present your research?

Skills I will use:

I will be researching, collecting, playing, cutting, sticking, designing, drawing and writing and evaluating.

How an adult can help me: Help me research toys from around the world and find exciting facts to present in my final piece.

Questions to think about:

What country will you pick your toy from?
How will you make your final piece eye-catching?

Resources I will need:

Books, paper, arts and craft materials, internet and games.

Context: This term our topic will be Toy Story where the children will be learning about old and new toys. We will be exploring how toys are made and what materials are used to make them. Children will be looking at toys from around the world and comparing them to the toys they have at home.

Literacy and Numeracy Activities:

Week 1:

Literacy: Can you describe the three Billy Goats Gruff? E.g. One is big and one is tiny.

Extension: Can you circle your capital letters and full stops?

Numeracy: Can you practise counting down from 30 - 0? Extension: What is the highest number you can count back from?

Week 2

Literacy: Can you draw a picture of your favourite book character and a speech bubble showing what they are saying? Extension: Can you put the speech into a sentence?

Numeracy: Can you find transparent and opaque objects around your home and sort them on to a Venn diagram?

Extension: Which group was the most common?

Week 3

Literacy: Can you punctuate these sentences? E.g. add full stops, exclamation marks and/or question marks.

the sun is shining outside
it will be fun

Numeracy: Take 4 coins. Can you order them in size? Can you order them in value? E.g. from smallest to largest.

Extension: Can you add some of the coins together?
