Week 1: Begin researching into the Ancient Egyptians' beliefs about the afterlife. How were their ideas about the afterlife similar or different to views people have now (think about different religions' ideas about the afterlife)?

Week 2: Now, make some notes and sketches about Canopic Jars. What were they used for? What was important about how they were designed? What does the word 'Canopic' mean?

Week 3: Investigate Tutankhamen and his tomb. Make a sketch of his sarcophagus. What is the difference between a tomb and a sarcophagus?

Week 4: For the last two weeks of this project, you will make a model of Tutankhamen's sarcophagus. Start gathering spare materials from around your house (the recycling bin is always a good place to start!) and make some plans and designs for your model.

Week 5: When you have your plans, designs and materials ready, use this week to make the model. If you have some extra time, you could even make a model of Tutankhamen's mummified body!
