Week 1: Research monarchs using secondary sources such as the internet, newspaper article for modern day monarchs. Choose one monarch and create a fact file which includes key information of the monarch's early life, the dates the monarch reigned, the monarch's date of birth, the death of the monarch and the important changes the monarch brought into the society and any interesting facts that you found about the monarch.

Week 2: Think about how you would create your crown and which materials you would choose. Start working on the design. Be sure to allow enough time to get all your resources to create the crown.

Week 3: Write a paragraph to explain why you have chosen the materials that you have used to complete your version of the crown.
